I have lived in Upton Bishop for many decades and I have never ever seen anyone fishing at this lake since it was excavated and more to the point I know a bit about fishing and there is no way fish of any quantity or quality can exist in this brown muddy Herefordshire water.

I would say the applicant and their many agents are just grasping at straws and are being very economical with the truth.

The B4221 is a very busy road and vehicles regularly exceed the 60mph speed limit, with the visibility from the site being extremely poor.

The flooding is a major problem and this is confirmed on the video submitted earlier this year. No proper consideration has been given to the drainage and for it to be assumed that it all okay to be drained into Two Parks Farm land is outrageous. The Land Drainage Report dated 5<sup>th</sup> March 2025 has confirmed what the objectors have already stated.

We all know that these sort of set ups for holiday homes will in due course be sold off for permanent housing which has already happened in Herefordshire and surrounding counties.
