



- ① New green oak framed garden room.
- ② Windows renewed as copy of best existing window (note 4), with leaded lights. To be oak framed with metal casements, fitted with thin high performance double glazed units. Stained/oiled finish. Middle window to be reconfigured with 2 opening casements to allow for escape.
- ③ Window renewed as copy of best existing window (note 4), with plain instead of leaded lights. To be oak framed with metal casements, fitted with thin high performance double glazed units. Stained/oiled finish. Reinstall horizontal rail below.

- ④ Most intact window pattern for restoration of farm house windows.
- ⑤ Existing windows replaced with metal casements. Replaced weathering detail in lead faced canopy.
- ⑥ Reinstall rotted out post and sole plate ends.
- ⑦ Re-roof existing cupboard extension in clay tiles to match existing.
- ⑧ Remove existing brick chimney serving AGA
